How to access cancer screening in NSW, as a Medicare Card Holder.



Cervical Screening

Complete a cervical screening test every 5 years, from 25 years old. Call 1800 627 701 to see when to book your test with your doctor or women's health nurse.



Breast Screening

Have a mammogram every 2 years after you turn 50. Call BreastScreen NSW on 13 20 50 to book an appointment for free.



Bowel Screening

Use your bowel test kit when it arrives in the post, after you turn 50. Make sure your address is up to date with Medicare and expect a new one every 2 years. If you are over 45, but under 50, you can now request a kit early through your doctor or by calling 1800 627 701.
